you and your family to be and feel safe. We have been facing lots of joys and challenges lately and we are glad to be able to share them with you. Elsa is doing well, and kids are growing in stature and with God. Emmanuel has almost finished his 1st grade and Abigail her 6th grade. They do enjoy school a lot. God has been teaching us about rest and withdrawal for quality time with God. As we enter the new season of summer, our worship service has been moved to Saturday evenings. We enjoyed now and then taking time to **rest and recharge.** This is not always easy but it's good when we do this.

TEAMS: Lately we have hosted 3 teams from bible schools that we are in contact. Teams that visited, brought lots of joy and passion. We believe is great time to be able to work together for the harvest. Teams who visited came each with a different project. One came to work with the refugees, the other with prisoner's ministry and another for a church children camps and evangelism. Last May on a pastors' conference we received a **new direction from God that he would like us to get involved and proclaim the gospel also among the people in the Army.** We received this with open hearts and have started to get involved in prison ministry. We are a young church each team brings a puzzle in the mosaic of building up his kingdom in people hearts.

Adrian's Story: Adrian has been in prison for 8 years. When I first meet with him 3 months ago, he always stayed in the last row of the room. He was one of 40 prisoners that would come in our worship service. I asked him to join bible study group together with 10 other men. Adrian is serving the drinks on the 3rd picture. He participated regularly for 10 weeks. He told us; I felt outside of Christianity most of my life but now not only Christianity is part of me, but I also want to bring this hope of faith to the others. Together, we have started now a second bible study group where he serves with bible reading, prayer and sharing testimonies. God brought joy in my heart to see the gospel being received and giving it's effects on transforming lives.

Unity with other pastors is what we pray and long for. We have seen this growing lately as we were part of few retreats and pastoral conferences. These times of intense worship and fellowship bring lots of encouragement for the ministry. There is a deep prayer and longing to see God's kingdom grow in Albania. We do pray regularly once a month on our church service for each of the churches in our city. Besides meeting with other pastors, I try to have regular meetings also with catholic priests. Please pray with to keep this peace and unity. Please pray for protection and wisdom which is so much needed on this matter of unity and collaboration as we live in a very segregated world and mindset in these days.
